Anonymous School Safety Reporting Tool

The number one priority of our school is to educate students in a safe and



caring environment. To keep our school as safe as

it can be we need to know when there are safety concerns that need to be dealt with. In response to this need, we have established a Tip/Report Hot-Line link on the Eureka County School District homepage.

Tip lines provide a safe, confidential way for students, parents, and the community to alert authorities about information that may be useful in preventing school attacks, bullying, and suicidal behaviors. Please use this tip line as needed; we are only as good as the information we have.

New Vaccine Requirement

We ran this article last month, but it bears repeating: Students enrolling in 7th grade after June 30, 2017 are required to have an immunization against meningitis. This new requirement **does not apply** to students who were enrolled in a Nevada public or private school before July 1, 2009. 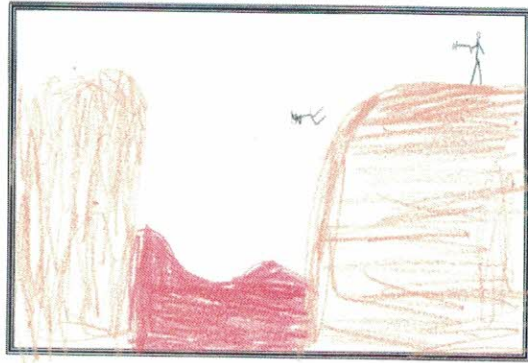

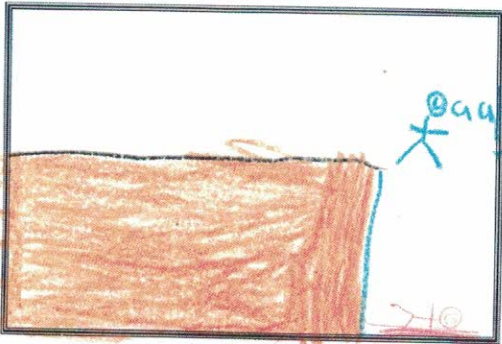
